

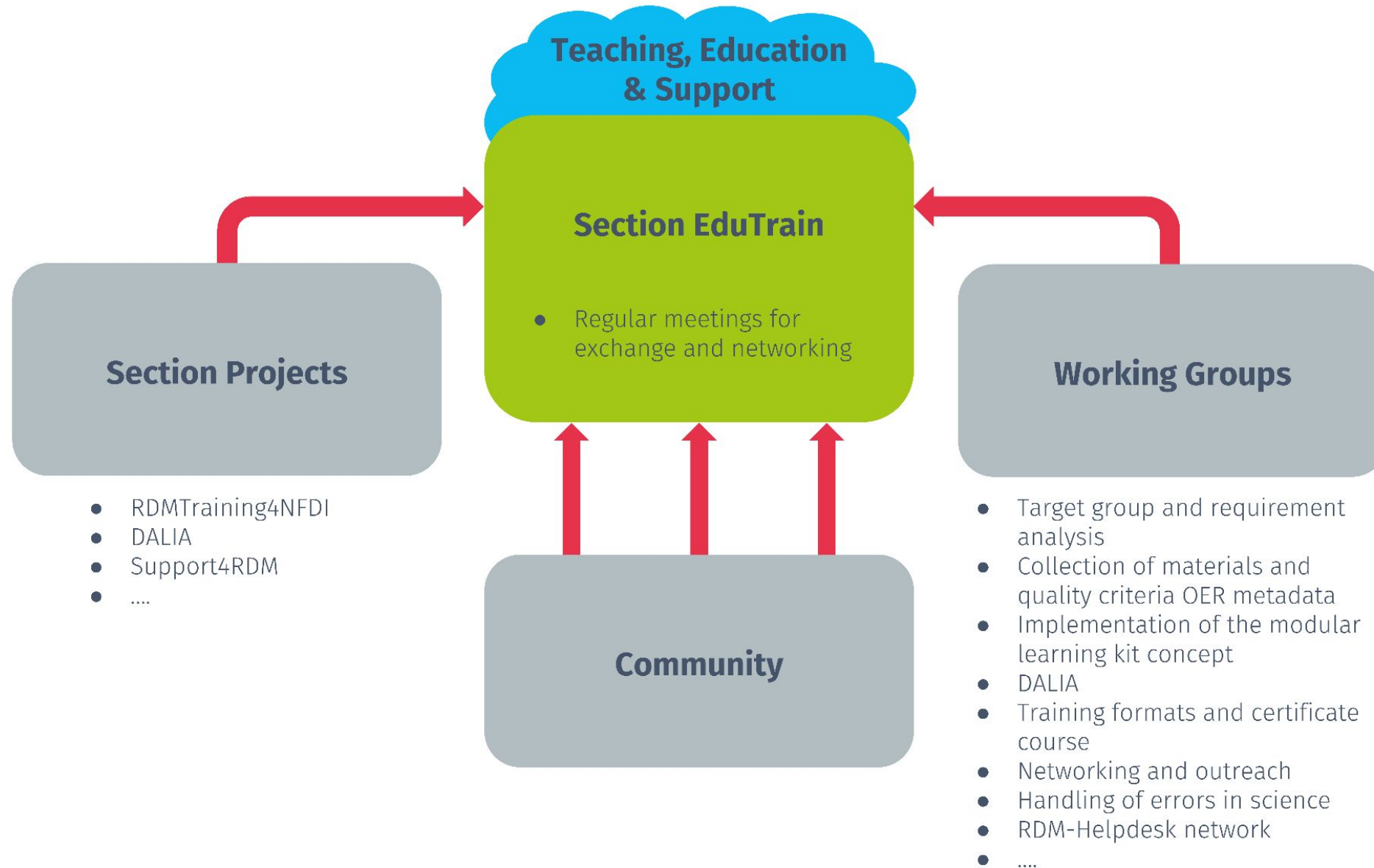

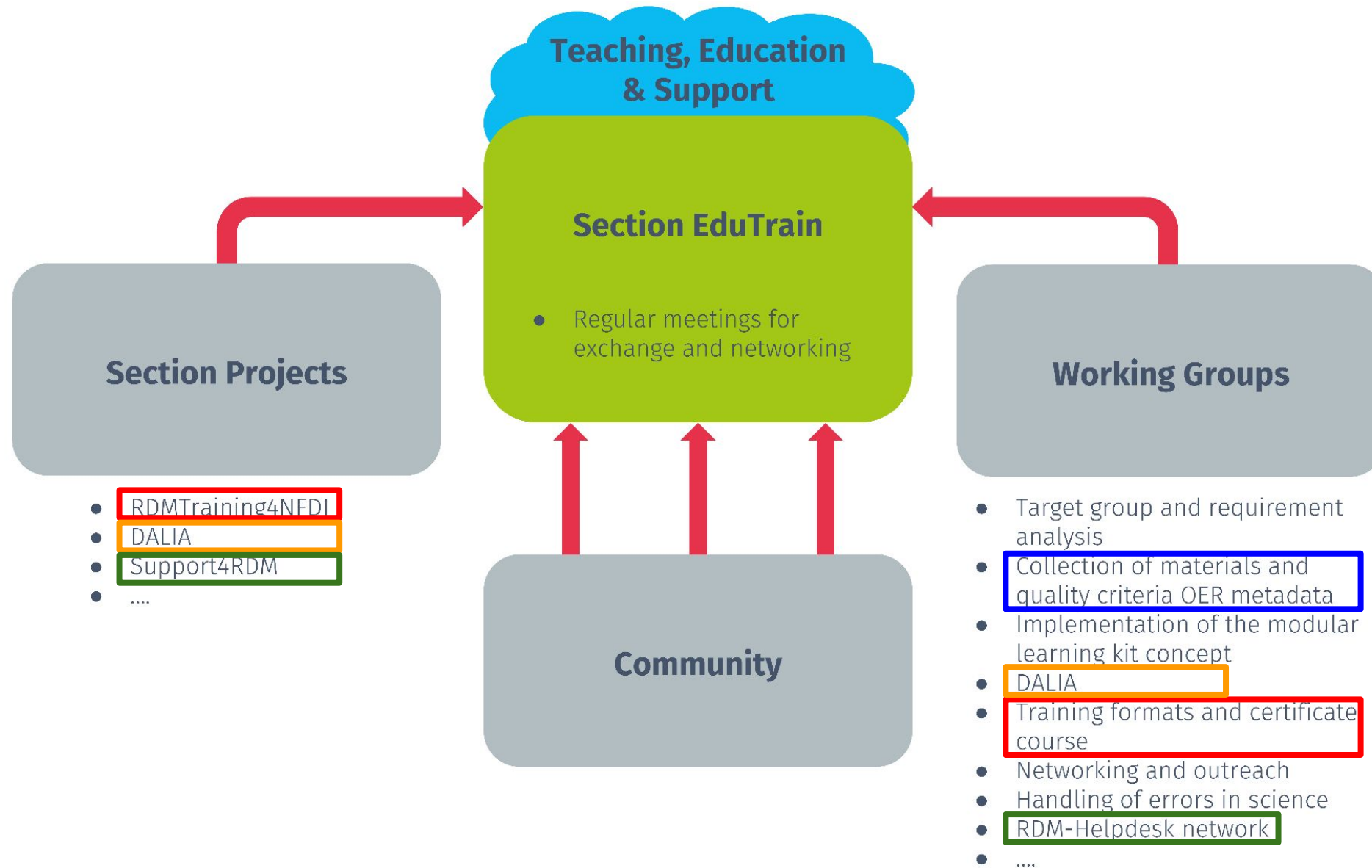

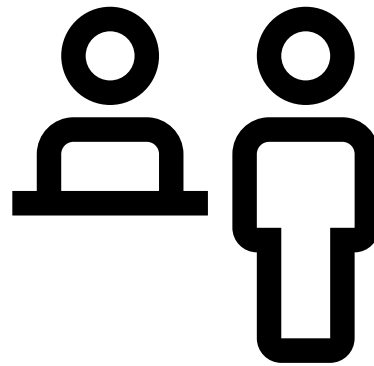


Connecting Research Data Management Support in Germany

What do we mean by “helpdesk”?

We understand the term *helpdesk* in a broad sense comprising the helpdesk infrastructure as well as any kind of support and consulting services regarding RDM.

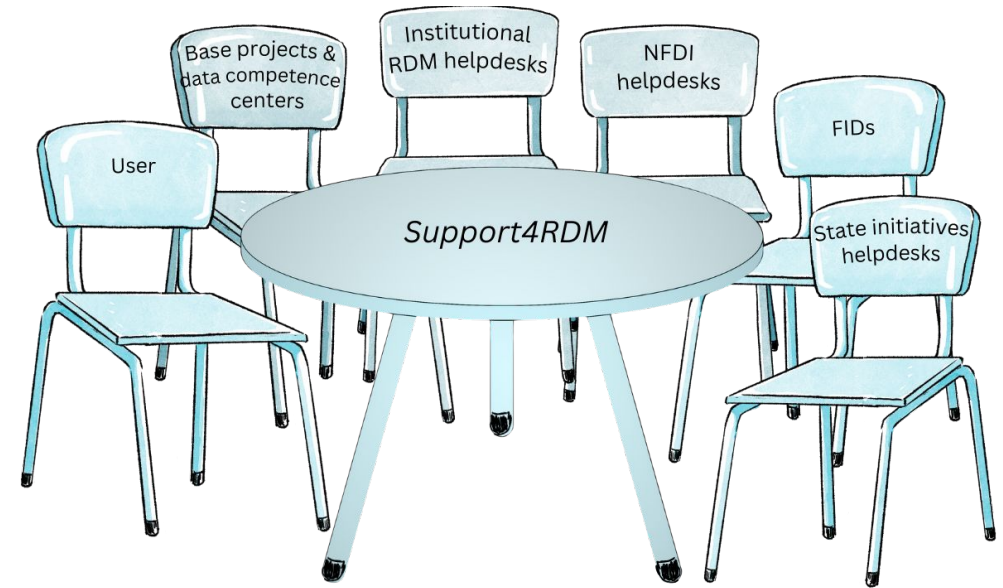

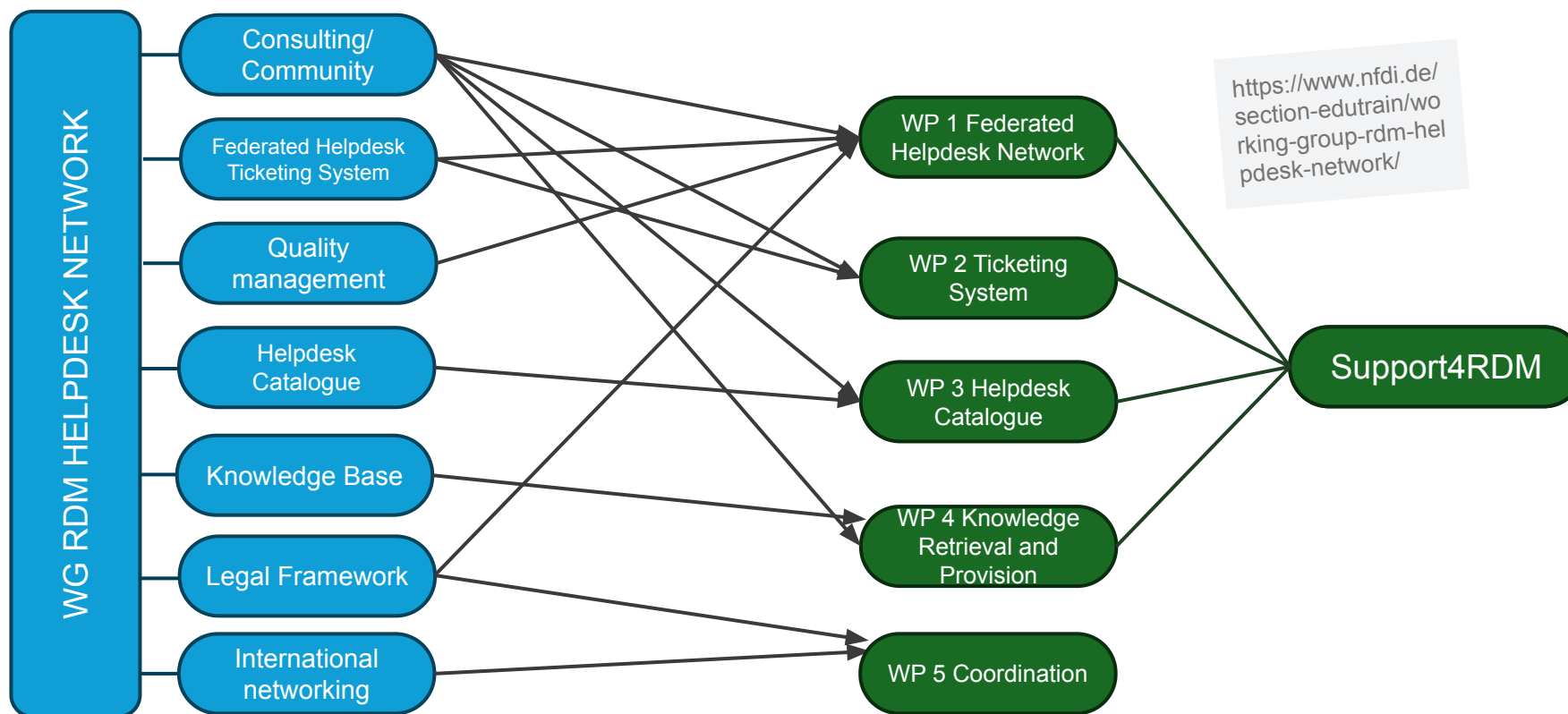

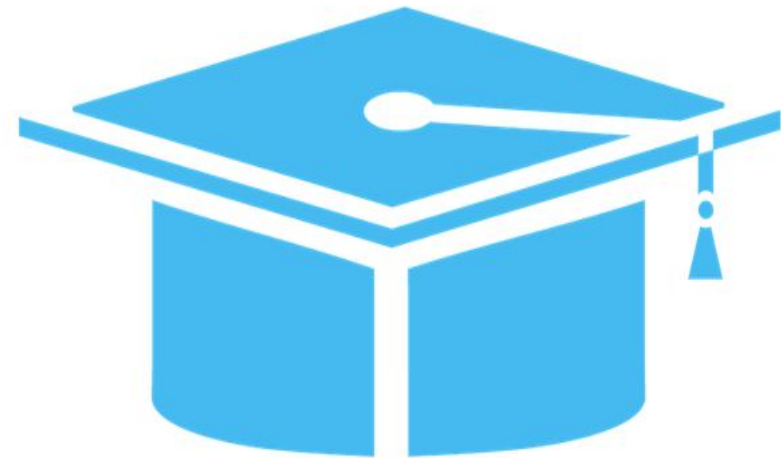

Overview: RDMTraining4NFDI

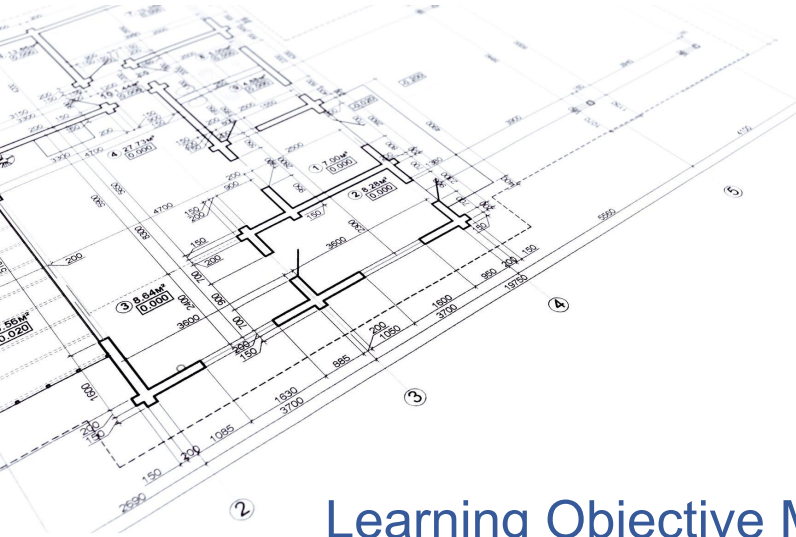
- A service aimed at improving research data management through teaching, training and community support
- Target group: RDM multipliers (i.e. Data Stewards, trainers, librarians) who disseminate knowledge and training
- Foci:
 - Training Execution
 - Testing Training Formats
 - Harmonizing RDM Training
 - Certification
 - Community Support

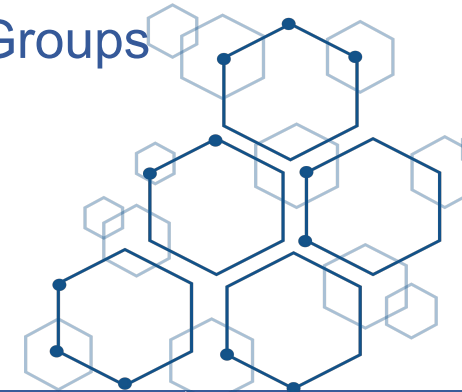

DATA AFFAIRS – Datenmanagement für ethnografische Forschung

DATA AFFAIRS ist eine frei zugängliche Plattform, die qualitative arbeitenden (ethnografischen) Wissenschaftler*innen und Lehrenden einen Überblick über Bestände des Forschungsdatenmanagements geben und zum verteilten Selbststudium einladen will. Sie wurde im Sonderforschungsbereich 1171 „Reflexive Digitalität“ entwickelt.

DATA AFFAIRS setzt den Fokus auf die Herausforderungen des Datenmanagements, die sich speziell bei der Arbeit mit qualitativen Daten in der ethnografischen Forschung ergeben. Das Portal legt zu einer breiten Auswahl an Ressourcen mit den Funktionen von Open Science an und unterstützt gleichzeitig bei der Reflexion und systematischen Umgang mit ethnografischen Forschungsdaten.
